ART CREATION COMPETITION

The Erasmus + *Sorry Taki Mami Klimat* - Such is our climate- project, in which our school participates, has as its main objectives to raise student awareness of environmental issues related to air, water and land. Through the various mobilities, practical and theoretical activities are carried out that develop in our students skills closely linked to environmental education.

Another important part of this project is based on artistic creation as a way of disseminating, making visible or criticising environmental problems.

Thanks to the wide field that the artistic and visual terrain offers us, images have been developed, from logos to photographs that reveal curiosity and concern for the environment.

This competition focuses on raising awareness of recycling and care for the environment by betting on the use of reused, biodegradable or low-polluting materials and resources to develop creativity among the youngest.

Rules:

1. All the projects presented must be made with **recycled materials**, reducing as much as possible the use of toxic products such as varnishes, dyes, plastics...
2. The theme will be about **caring for the environment**, focusing on the **earth** as an **element** of nature that is **fundamental** for the **survival of species**.
3. The different artistic proposals must be developed in **groups of two to four** people. Each group can present **ONLY ONE WORK**.

4. The projects will be presented in **photographic format**, with a total of **three photographs** to be sent:
5. Two photographs of the **process**, showing the **authorship** and **execution** of the project by the students of the centre.
6. One photograph of the **final project** with a **neutral background**. If the work consists of a sculpture or installation, two photographs may be taken of it from different perspectives to show the work as a whole.
7. The works must be sent to the e-mail address recycledartcontest@colegioseneca.es , indicating the **following details** in the body of the e-mail:
 - o Title of the work
 - o Name, surname and age of the pupils.
 - o School, year and group.
8. There will be **two categories**, established according to the age of the participants
 - o **6-15** years old
 - o **16-19** years old
9. The competition **starts** on **28 November 2023**
10. The **deadline** for submitting these projects is **20 February 2024**
11. The finalists will be chosen by a jury made up of teachers from the three participating schools. The following **aspects** will be **positively evaluated**, in addition to complying with the rules of this competition:
 - o **Appropriateness of the theme.**
 - o **Creativity in the image or concept.**
 - o **Appropriate technique and correct materials.**
